Introduction

Situated in the heart of the city, Government Post Graduate College, Ambala Cantt, since its inception in 1997, is a prominent name in the field of higher education in the state of Haryana. The College has been striving hard to uphold its vision to achieve academic excellence through the holistic approach for providing a safe, inclusive and dynamic learning environment, facilitating access to quality higher education to produce inspiring leaders and nation builders for tomorrow. In addition to meaningfully engaging students in knowledge pursuits and research, the College also sensitizes students instilling in them the values of honesty, tolerance, trust and responsibility in social, moral and academic matters.

Catering to the needs of students from urban as well as rural areas, the College is only half-a-kilometer from ISBT and Ambala Cantt Railway Junction. This easy to approach location is an added advantage for its stakeholders. The College spreads over 6.5 acres of land and provides good infrastructural facilities for the students as well as the staff. It has 43 class-rooms, 8 Smart class-rooms, 4 Computer labs, Language Lab, 17 labs for different subjects, 6 ICT-enabled class-rooms, sports-ground, a mini gymnasium, an Auditorium, ICT enabled Seminar Hall, Girls' Common-room and Students' home. Well maintained parks, RO water facility, separate and clean toilets for girls, boys and staff almost on every floor, parking area for vehicles, College canteen, well furnished and ventilated staff-room and departmental rooms, well-equipped Administrative block and Library with INFLIBNET database are other domains in which this College excels.

At Under-Graduate level the College runs three regular streams— Humanities, Sciences and Commerce, along with vocational course in Computer Application and professional courses in Business Administration, Tourism Management and Mass Communication and Journalism. It offers a choice of **12** subjects for the students of (Arts) Humanities; General and Computer Application for the students of Commerce; and Medical, Non-Medical and Computer Application (C.Sc) for the students of Science streams. The College also has Post-Graduate courses in the subjects of Hindi, English, Punjabi, History, Economics, Geography and Commerce. Besides the above courses the college also impart higher education in 5 Certificate courses as Value Added Courses as approved by the State government.

Despite the fateful onslaught of Covid-19 during the session 2020-2021, the College has performed well and upheld its spirits. The credibility well earned through the last 25 years brought a strength of more than 1500 students in different courses (UG and PG) at the entry level. The College recorded a total strength of 3341 students in the session 2020-2021 and the very number of girl students enrolled in different courses further speaks volumes about the safety and gender sensitized environment that this College promises.

Dedicated and diligent team of **118** teachers (Regular 84, Guest faculty 04, Extension lecturers 348.) with the help of Assisting staff of 11 (Lab Attendants, Computer Instructors regular and contractual) under the competent guidance of the Principal, ensuring regular classes for students in offline and online modes as per the directions of the Government from time to time, brought laurels to the College as the total pass percentage of students stands undefeated at% in the University Examinations.

The College being a Government institute receives a number of Annual Grants-in-Aid such as Library Grant, Passport Grant, Women Cell Grant, Road Safety Grant, Augmentation of Laboratories, earn While You Learn, etc. for different activities and purposes. During the session 2020-21, it received a total amount of Rs. 28,36,583/- as Grants. The income generated through all the Funds during this session was Rs. 1,24,90,232/- and utilization of Rs. 28,85,447/- out of Funds was certified by the Chair. One of the identifiable achievements of this year that needs a special mention is the completion of long pending Audit of different Funds upto march 2021 by the Department of Local Audit, Govt. of Haryana.

COMMITTEES, CELLS AND CLUBS

Decentralization of power and sharing of responsibility has the potential of instilling life in an institute as it creates a workforce with a promise of mutual bonding, respect and harmony. The College administration runs through a number of Committees, Cells and Clubs allocated annually to the staff in the beginning of a new session. Achievements and activities of different Committees, Cells and Clubs have been mentioned hereafter:

1. EARN WHILE YOU LEARN COMMITTEE

The Earn While You Learn Committee of the college provided opportunities to 101 students to earn while they learn through entrepreneurial and part-time jobs. The total amount allotted to accomplish the tasks for the session 2020-2021 was 3,50,000/-Rs. Thirty-eight boys and sixty three girls benefitted out of this scheme.

2. BEAUTIFICATION/ CLEANLINESS/ DECORATION COMMITTEE

The Beautification, Cleanliness, Decoration committee of the college worked assiduously during the entire session to revamp and beautify the College campus. The committee carried out various construction and repairing works such as construction of brick rings around trees, construction of drainage channels, leveling of grounds, and repairing of bricked flower beds. For beautification purpose, the committee purchased more than 125 saplings and plants along with pots of cement, clay, terracotta and fibre for plantation. The committee also placed idol of Maa Saraswati in the Reception Area of Administrative block.

Despite the challenges of Covid-19 lockdown and non-availability of grant from the higher authorities, the Guidance, Counseling and Placement Cell of the College remained energetic and mentored students for their professional career. The guidance imparted to the students remained fruitful as ten students from the College got placement in various fields and firms during the academic session 2020-2021. Avni Deswal, a student of B.A. III, got selected as Lieutenant in Indian Army. The nine students from BCA got placements in renowned companies such as TCS, Wipro, Infosys, Webmob, and Cognizant.

6. WRITE OFF COMMITTEE

The Write Off Committee of the College provides well-maintained and safe educational environment for effective resource utilization. The committee inspected the unserviceable material/items of the Departments of Botany, Chemistry, Physics and Sports. Besides this, the Committee also inspected discarded plastic, iron, and wooden items from various Departments and presented a detailed report to the Principal. The base value of all the non-electric and non-electronic items has been evaluated by the Supplies and Disposal Department, Govt. Haryana as Rs. 10,23,190.90/-. (Rs. Ten Lakh, twenty three thousand, one hundred and Ninety). Similarly a huge number of IT and electronic items have also been processed for write off being unserviceable through HARTRON.

7. YOUTH RED CROSS COMMITTEE AND RED RIBBON CLUB

The Youth Red Cross committee and Red Ribbon Club organized numerous programmes and events in the academic session 2020-2021 to spread awareness among the students. equipments. The College received a total amount of Rs. 20 lakh only, out of the sanctioned grant, during the academic session 2020-21. Apart from that a proposal for purchase of equipment and construction of parking area has been sent to the Department of Higher Education.

10. TRAFFIC INTERPRETATION CELL AND ROAD SAFETY CLUB

Traffic Interpretation Cell and Road Safety Club of the College received a total grant of Rs. 579000/ comprising Rs 40000 for the seminar, Rs. 12000/ for Awareness Campaign, Rs. 3500/ for Road Sign Wall Painting and Rs. 2400/- for Prize money for the competition-winners. Traffic Interpretation Cell and Road Safety Club organized Quiz contest, Essay Writing Competition, Poster- Making and Slogan-Writing competitions to raise awareness regarding road safety. Furthermore, a Road Safety Awareness Campaign was launched by the Principal by organizing a workshop-cum-seminar in collaboration with the experts from Hero-Moto Corpos on 'Sadak Suraksha Jeevan Raksha' on 24.03.2021 in which 136 delegates from various colleges participated. A painting contest on the theme "Traffic Signs" was also organized by the cell.

The library provides access to online databases N-LIST and e-shodhsindhu consortium through which more than 6000 journals and 31,35000 e-books can be accessed. During the session, the staff members and students donated books in the Book Bank section of library to give assistance to needy students. National Librarian's Day was celebrated on August 12th, 2021 in the memory of S.R. Ranganathan.
