ABSTRACT

Agricultural development is an integral part of overall economic development of country like India. Though, the share of agricultural sector in gross domestic product (GDP) of India, has reduced from 58 percent (1951-52) to about 17.3 percent (2016-17), still it is considered a decisive driver, in order to achieve 8 to 9 percent growth in GDP. For agricultural development, adequate and timely availability of credit to the farmers is vital and indispensable, as it acts as a catalyst, to move the farmers from traditional to modern agriculture. Agricultural institutional credit has been growing continuously, after the nationalization and other banking sector reforms. But, past experience shows declining trend, in recovery performance of the banks and rural indebtedness, which is affecting adversely the disbursement of agricultural credit. The main reason behind the problem of low recovery is, misutilization of agricultural loan amount, as farmers do not utilize the loan amount, for the purpose for which it is taken. It becomes more dangerous, when agricultural credit amount is utilized for unproductive purposes, which do not generate any income. In light of the

It has also been realised that no conciliation is possible till we revisit and face our past confidently and objectively. Sometimes, the memories of the past refuse to fade away as are the memories of the Partition. Now the question arises, how to negotiate the path towards resolving and accepting the deeply embedded anguish, pain and sense of loss that is lying in the collective memory of the two suffering Punjabs; and how to forget and forgive others and our own selves for what happened during and after the partition of India? People from both the Punjabs have been recalling, remembering, reliving their moments of shame, loss, pain and grief. Those who miraculously escaped death during migration, lived in a perennial nightmare. Some could never sleep thereafter, some went mute and some persistent blubberers. The anguished narratives and agonised silences streamed along the immigrants on both the sides. Such huge sufferings and loss could hardly be chronicled in the annals of history or literature adequately. Krishna Sobti, a writer and a Partition refugee, once said that Partition was difficult to forget but dangerous to remember.

Writers, film makers, philosophers, historians, political scientists, psychologists - all have been trying diligently to comprehend and rationalise the frenzy, bigotry and sheer madness that overpowered the multitudes who would later on be
