Educational Tour to Dalhousie

An educational tour to Dalhousie was organized from 13-15th October 2016. The students of B.Sc. Medical of all the 3 yrs, were accompanied by Dr. Rohini Singh, Mr. Vikas and Mr. Indruch and Mr. Suresh Ranga. 46 students were there in all. The students saw the type of vegetation, change in pattern of vegetation according to the slope and altitude. The specimens from gns algae, fungi, bryophytes, pteridophytes, gymnosperms and Angiosperms were collected, dried and preserved. The students will prepare Herbarium with these specimens that will be shown to the external examiner in the practical examination. The students visited the various sites like Parthula, Lakar Mandi, Kheolan, Kala Top, Gandhi Chowk etc. The tour not only enhanced the knowledge of the subject but also helped in their overall development. Specimens for department of botany were also brought by Dr. Gauri Sen.
