- Abstract:**

The paper reports two cases of Conversion Disorder; one without any underlying physical pathology and the other coexisting with physical pathology. The patients presented with neurological symptoms including weakness of both lower limbs and gait disturbance and inability to walk. The severity of symptoms, in these patients could not be explained on the basis of medical examination and laboratory investigations. Medical treatment given were ineffective. On psychological interviewing, stress factors were detected which may have precipitated in the observed symptomatology. With the provisional diagnosis of conversion disorder, the patients were given appropriate psychotherapy. The patients were able to walk without any support.

The present paper on Philip Roth's novel *The Humbling* (2009) analyses how the sacrosanct ideals of a united family and marital life have begun to be questioned in the contemporary times. Philip Roth is a postmodernist as many of his works critique and parody grand narratives, meta-narratives and meta-ideologies ('standards') in *The Humbling*, he writes about the re-orientation of traditional family, which seems to shape its individuals physically and mentally. He shows that even though the different communities living in America have conventionally established stereotypes for their family lives, continue to be traditional and patriarchal with fathers often acting as family patriarchs for the next couple of years. Roth seems to suggest here that women should be treated as equals in the marriage. The protagonist's journey from the traditional marriage
