ABSTRACT

A sharp focus is a must on the financial health of the banking institutions, any lapse in management of banks, not only shakes the trust of citizens but also threatens the entire financial system of the country. The present study uses a set of parametric and non-parametric techniques for analyzing and comparing the financial performance of the public sector banks (PSBs) and the private sector banks (PrSBs) in India from 2009-10 to 2018-19.

In India, during the economic boom period, a large number of business projects had been financed or re-financed by the commercial banks, especially by the public sector
