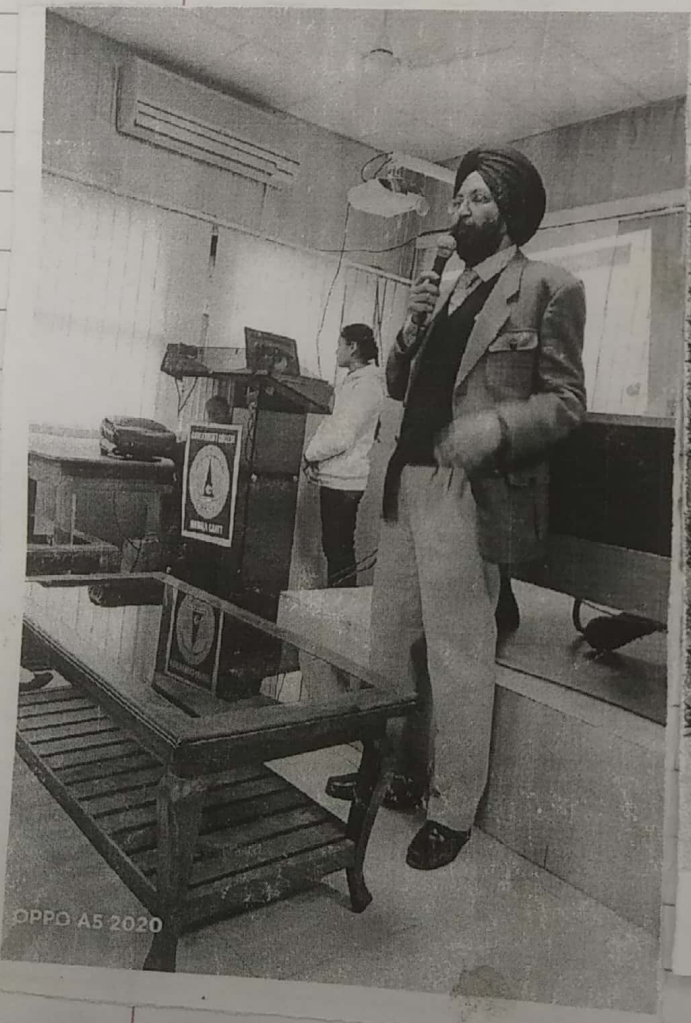

03 FEBRUARY 2020 :

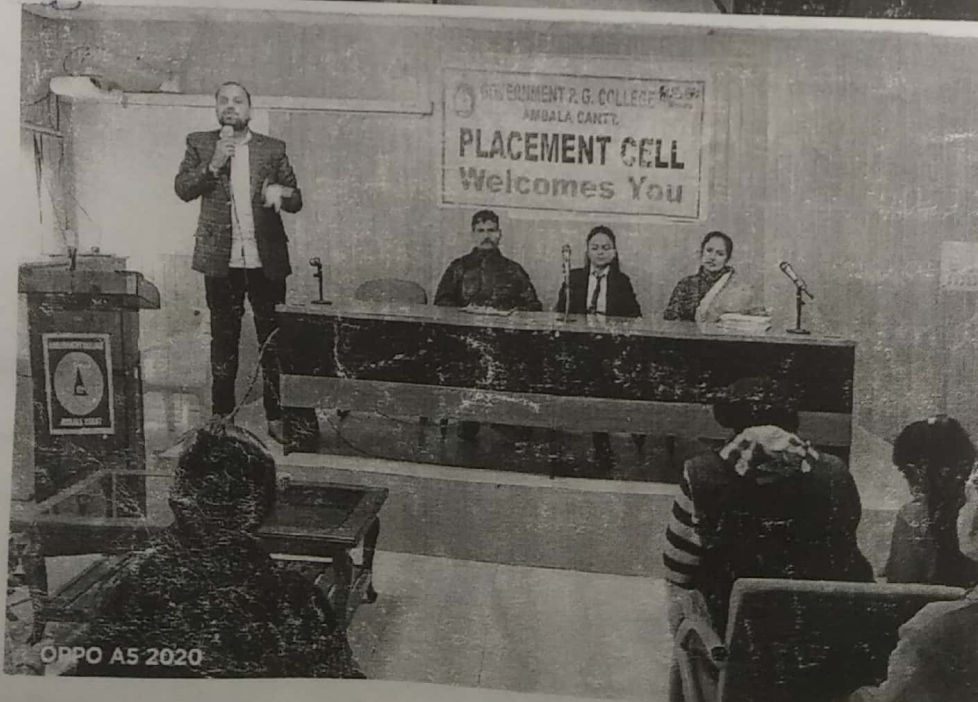
