The mentor mentee meet was conducted on 8th October, 2022 for both UG (TDC I, II, III) and PG (Final Year) students. Mentors were given following issues to discuss with the mentees:

- b. Clarifications relating to Gender Issues

Feedback from mentees pertaining to teachers was also shared with the mentors. These included:

- a. Rescheduling of lectures by teachers to be avoided
- b. Resources (books, PPTs recordings) to be made available to students.

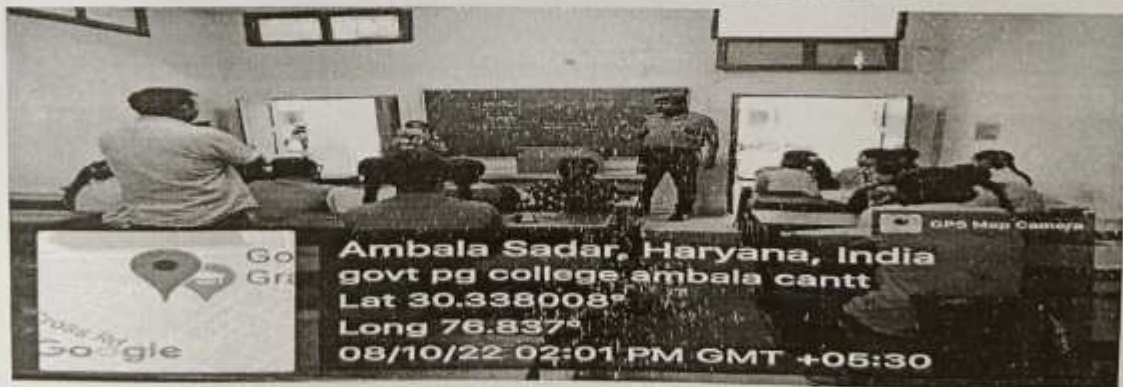


Mentor Groups
